Report of the July 20th Solar Eclipse

On July 20th 1963 a Solar Eclipse happened. It was visible in all parts of the United States. The eclipse was total in the states of Maine and Alaska. For the state of Maryland it was from 81% to 84% total in the city of Baltimore it was 83% total. Frank Stone and myself, Joseph Myko, saw the eclipse of the sun from Our Lady of Mt. Carmel Grounds.

On the morning of the eclipse there was a very overcast sky and it looked as if it would stay that way. About 11:30 A.M.* Frank and I went to Essep to get some film for his camera. On our way back it started to rain, we both thought it would rain all day. But about 12:30 P.M.* the sky began to clear. About 2 P.M.* we started
